**OBSTACLES AND RING SIZES**

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoors under cover on a packed dirt surface. Ring size will be 100’ x 100’ in both rings. Ring entrances/exits are gated.

**CLASSES OFFERED, JUDGES, & RING SCHEDULES\***

\*Ring start times and final class order will be provided in the final confirmation. The General & first Judge’s briefing & walk through will begin at 7:40 a.m. with the first ring starting @ 8:00 a.m.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

**JUMP HEIGHT CARD POLICY**

Jump height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has a check box to indicate if the dog needs to be measured. It is the owner’s responsibility to understand the rules, and if the dog needs to be measured, it is the owner’s/handler’s responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running. If you are unsure, contact the trial secretary for assistance.

## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs with a PAL/ILP or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. The owner may choose to enter their dog in Preferred classes and Regular classes at the same trial. A dog may only be entered once in each class offered. They may not enter a class in both Preferred and Regular. **If a dog is entered in Preferred and Regular classes the owner must submit two separate entry forms, one for Regular classes and one for Preferred classes.** After the close of entry for a trial a dog may not be moved between Regular and Preferred classes except as noted in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the AKC agility rules.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. **Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.**

## COURSE WALK-THRUS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of their class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

## RIBBONS AND PRIZES

Green flat ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division, as follows:

*First place*.....*Blue*  
*Second Place*.....*Red*  
*Third Place*.....*Yellow*  
*Fourth Place*.....*White*

- A MACH rosette and MACH bar will be awarded to dogs that achieve a MACH title.
- A PACH rosette and PACH bar will be awarded to dogs that achieve a PACH title.
- A PAX rosette and bar will be awarded to all dogs achieving a PAX title.
- A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dogs earning a new title!
- A QQ neckband rosette will be given to all dogs earning a qualifying score in both Master Standard and Master Jumpers on the same day.

## ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

The Walker Arena at GIHP is a large covered outdoor horse arena. Limited grandstand seating is available. If the weather is cold, dress in layers.

All dogs must be on a 6 foot or less leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated practice jump area.

**The Georgia International Park Rules prohibit the use of tobacco & tobacco products on the premises.**

**Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund by the Trial Committee.**

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Checks will not be deposited until after entries close.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

- **The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.
- **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The AOC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. AOC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the AOC or any official thereof.
- **All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

### REFUNDS

- **No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.
- **Bitches in season** and injured dogs are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund the entry fee paid for dogs unable to compete for these reasons, minus \$3.50 per run, upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate on the clinic's letterhead. This certificate must be presented with the refund request to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

### RINGSIDE

- **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- **Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for being ringside for their class. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- **This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

## RV PARKING

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.

## INCOMPLETE OR INVALID ENTRIES

Please be aware that Licensed trial secretaries are not allowed to accept incomplete or invalid entries. The following is from the AKC's directive to Trial Secretaries:

"Incomplete/Erroneous Entry Forms: A Trial Secretary may NOT make assumptions as to which class(es) or jump height an exhibitor wishes to enter. Examples include:

Multiple jump heights circled

A jump height that does not make sense based on what was written as the dog's "height at withers"

A mixture of regular and preferred classes circled

If an exhibitor's entry form is unclear, incomplete, or erroneous, it is an invalid entry and should not be accepted. At this point, the Trial Secretary only has two options:

- a) Communicate with the exhibitor via email and/or phone explaining what issues exist
- b) Return the invalid entry.

A Trial Secretary may NOT send a confirmation email to the exhibitor, making assumptions, asking that the exhibitor confirm that the assumptions are correct by reply email. At this point, you do not have a valid entry, therefore you should not be entering that exhibitor/dog into the trial, reserving class run counts, or sending an entry confirmation (especially a confirmation that is conditional upon receiving a reply).

Any changes to an exhibitor's entry form must be made in writing – a reply to your email communication is acceptable, at which time, having heard from the exhibitor, you may complete the entry so long as they respond prior to the closing date/time of the event. If you do not hear back by the closing date/time, you must return the invalid entry. "

## MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than **6 PM Monday, March 1, 2021** via e-mail, letter or fax.

Move-ups during the trial weekend will be accommodated, provided the information is received **before** the trial ends each day. Forms will be available at the trial.

## CONFIRMATIONS

- A preliminary confirmation will be sent to the email address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed.
- **Please review the information in the confirmation for errors and notify the Trial Secretary** of any corrections needed.
- If you do not have an email address, please send a stamped, self-addressed envelope for a preliminary confirmation.
- Final confirmations and the judging schedule will be sent to the email address on your entry form after the closing date.
- Final confirmations will be sent via US mail ONLY if an exhibitor does not have an active email address or upon specific request.

Setup will be at 3 p.m. on Thursday at the Walker Arena. Times are subject to change so check your Final Confirmation letter or the AOC Agility Facebook page the week of the trial. Anyone helping unload/setup will receive \$10 in worker bucks.

Crates, etc. may be left overnight; however, the Atlanta Obedience Club and the Georgia International Horse Park will not be responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen items left at the show site.

# COVID Rules

Please be aware that by entering and attending a trial, you are putting yourself at greater risk for exposure to the Coronavirus than if you stayed at home. The Atlanta Obedience Club will be following state, local, and Georgia International Horse Park (GIHP) mandates at the time of our event. Updates will be provided prior to closing on our website.

**By signing your entry form, you and any family you bring with you, agree to follow these rules.**

Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the trial and you will be asked to leave GIHP with no refund of entry fees or RV/camping fees.

We understand that everyone has different feelings about what should or should not be allowed at an outdoor trial. We ask that you respect what we feel are necessary rules for the safety of everyone involved. If you feel that you cannot abide by the rules and guidelines listed below, please do not enter our trial.

- We highly recommend avoiding going out to places where you might be exposed to the virus in the weeks leading up to the trial.
  - If you are sick or have been exposed to anyone who is currently sick, is suspected being sick, or has tested positive, you MUST stay home. You must notify the club by Thursday, March 4th to receive a partial refund. If you become ill during the event you MUST notify the Trial Secretary or Trial Chair and then immediately leave the trial. Please do not risk anyone's health for a dog trial.
  - Masks must be worn in the Walker Arena trial area while volunteering, walk thrus, walking around or waiting to run your dog. **Both judges respectfully ask that you wear your mask for everyone's safety when running your dog but it is not required. We will have silicone inner mask support guards available that make it easier to breathe with a mask on.**
  - Crating will be allowed on the platform above the arena floor and outside around the arena. Crating areas will be marked for social distancing. We ask that you crate from your car if possible. We will be using both the Agility Gate and the Remind apps.
  - There will be no course maps individually printed and given out. Course maps will be on the Agility Gate app and posted around the arena. You may take pictures with your phone. The FB page "AOC Agility" for the trial will also have maps posted the night before.
  - We will be using the Agility Gate app to help keep you up to date on the running of the trial. You will find information about this on our trial website and in your final confirmation.
- Only workers, club members, judges and the next 4-5 handlers due in the ring will be allowed around the rings while dogs are running. There is no seating between the crating area or around the rings. There are bleachers where you can watch your friends run. Class walk-thru procedures will be in the final confirmation and on our Facebook page. Please do not gather in large groups and maintain social distancing when waiting for your walk thrus.
  - LEASHES: We will have a leash runner using a claw holder or you may choose to carry your leash on you while you are running. Plan which method you will use and practice if you intend to carry your leash. There will be a table in the finish area where you may place any toys, treats or leash/harness you will need at the end of your run. As per AKC rules, you must enter and exit the ring with a leash on your dog.
  - RIBBONS will be awarded as always. You must use the provided hand sanitizer before collecting your ribbons and stickers. Please notify the gate if running for a MACH, PACH, or PAX.
  - Please be mindful that the judges need to be left alone when they are at their table working. If you need to speak to them about a problem, please do so when they are out on the floor or come to the secretary table and we will get them for you. Masks must be worn when at the secretary and judges table area.
  - This is a challenging time for all of us. Simply putting on a trial is hard. We are going to ask you to please be respectful of everyone while you are at our trial. We are saddened that we must require masks, not gather in groups, and must maintain social distancing. We care for all of you and your dogs. That is the reason we are putting on this trial. That said, we take this virus very seriously, want everyone to be safe, and we expect that you will do the same while you are with us during the trial.



# Georgia International Horse Park

## COVID Guidelines

### What We Ask of Our Guests:

The Georgia International Horse Park has put preventive measures in place due to the spread of Covid-19, however attending an event could increase your risk of contracting the coronavirus. By entering the facility, you voluntarily assume all risk and agree that you will not hold the Georgia International Horse Park, City of Conyers, Proof of the Pudding, Event Producers, and all associations liable for any resulting illness or injury.

- All guests must comply with all applicable federal, state and local regulations, requirements and orders as they relate to mass gatherings and sporting events, including the latest Governor's Executive Order for the State of Georgia.
  - Give fellow guests and event participants their space. Avoid close contact with others by standing or sitting at least 6 feet apart at all times.
  - Do not congregate. Avoid congregating in areas such as the show office, barns, ringside, bleachers, seating, restrooms, or other areas. No gatherings are allowed on the property with more than 50 people, unless there is at least 6 feet between each person.
  - Wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) when possible.
  - The GIHP strongly encourages guests wear masks on property as practicable in areas that can have a high concentration of people, such as barn areas, arena complex, vendor areas, spectator areas, concession areas, show offices, registration areas, and in any indoor or covered buildings. Masks do not have to be worn when mounted on a horse, competing in a horse show or sporting event, warming up for a competition or sporting event, or while eating or drinking. Review the latest State of Georgia Executive Order for current recommendations for wearing face masks.
  - Frequently wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing.
  - Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
  - Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue and dispose of properly.
  - Stay at home if you are sick or experiencing symptoms of illness, including fever, cough, shortness of breath, or loss of taste.
  - Stay at home if you have pre-existing health conditions or if you fall into the State of Georgia's high-risk category for COVID-19.
  - If you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks, stay at home.
  - Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using regular household cleaning spray or wipes.
